Update: Deprecating Assignments

Rationale:

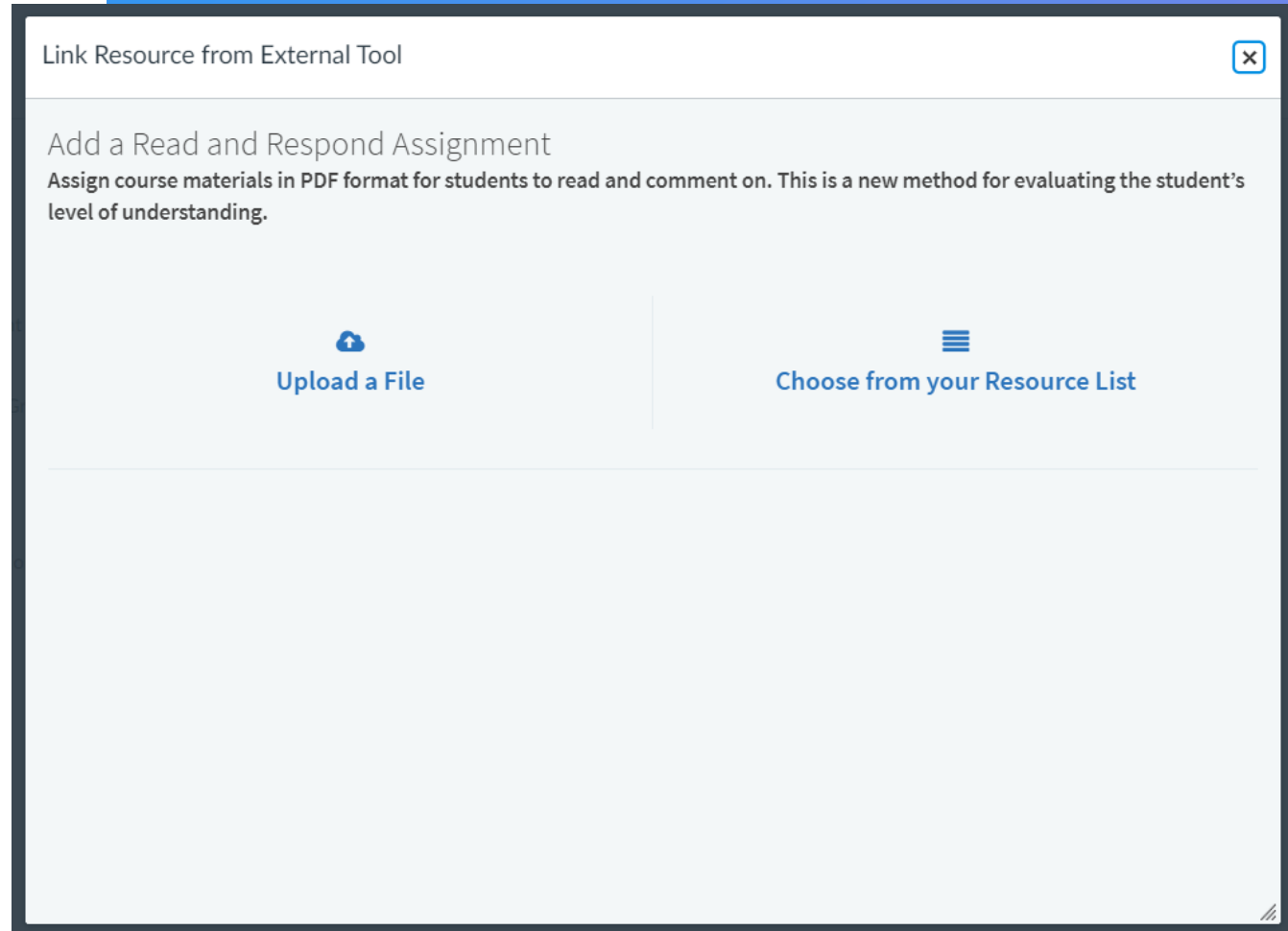
- Functionality is not heavily used and difficult to maintain.
- Libraries report it is difficult to support.
- Libraries report concerns about holding student grades in a library system.

Action items:

- Recommend removing advertisements, instructions, demos, etc. in 2025.
- Final timing will be in consideration of any instructors using the functionality.

Note:

- Social reading (private and public annotations within a Leganto list) will be preserved.
