

## 07 Create a new BIBFRAME Instance from template

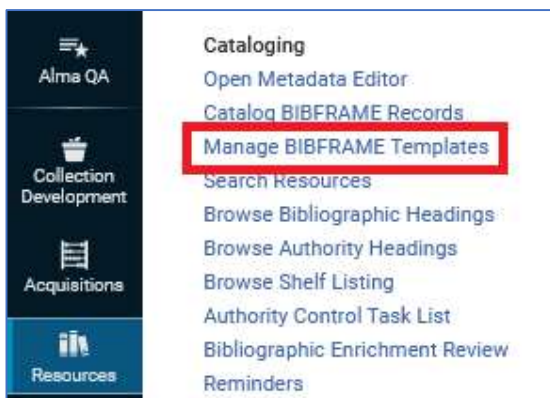

The purpose of this exercise is to see how to create a new Instance from a template. We already learned how to edit and add fields to an Instance when we did the exercise "Create a new BIBFRAME Instance from scratch for the Work we created". Here we are focusing on using the template.

In this exercise we will create a BIBFRAME Instance from a template, fill in the title, then add a section and then add a standalone field. After saving and releasing the record we will search for and retrieve it.

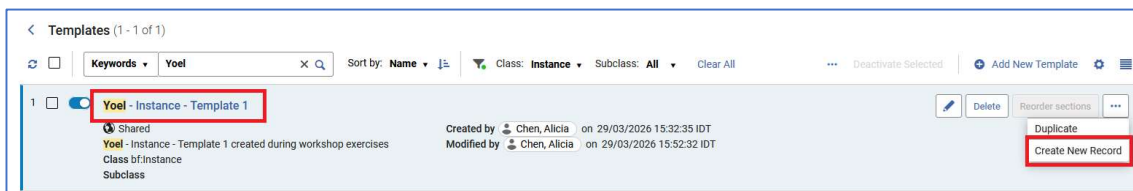
### ONE

Access the "Manage BIBFRAME templates" page at "Resources > Cataloging > Manage BIBFRAME templates"



### TWO

Retrieve the template for an Instance which we created in a previous exercise and choose "Action Items > Create New Record"



### THREE

Fill in the title with any title (and remember it because we will use it later). Typically this would be a title which is similar to or identical with the Work to which we will soon link this Instance

**FOUR**

Scroll to the field "Instance of" and use the 'Lookup' to search for the Work which we previously created and select it so that this Instance is in an Instance of the Work:

**FIVE**

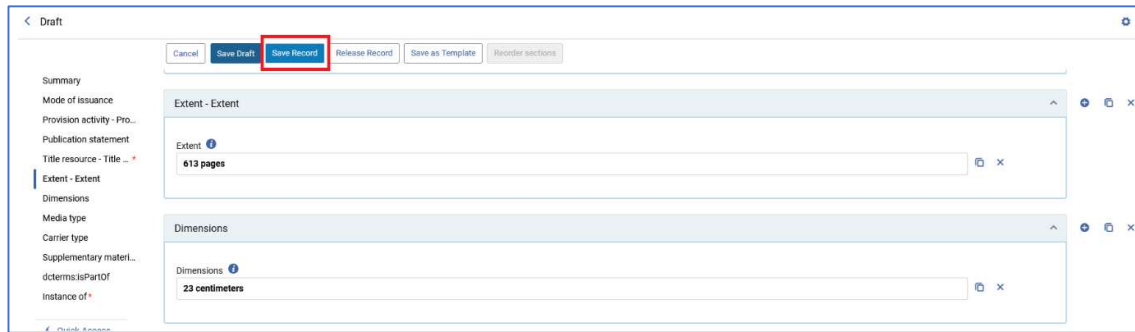
Fill in the Extent and Dimensions:

**SIX**

Fill in any existing fields and add any additional fields as desired as we did when creating the Instance from scratch

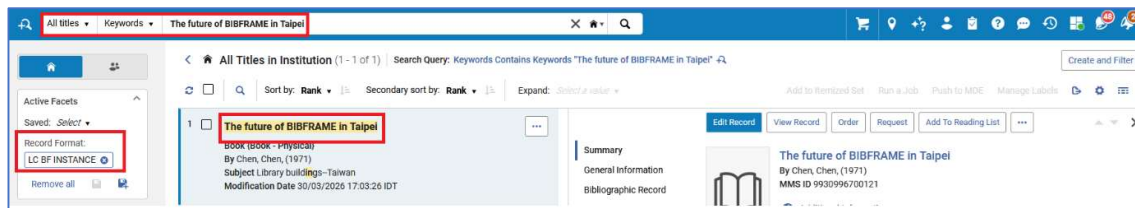
**SEVEN**

On the top click "Save Record"



## EIGHT

Search for the new Instance and confirm that it can be retrieved.
