August 10	<p><b>New Resource Sharing Task Lists</b></p> <p>The Resource Sharing task lists (borrower and lender) are being redesigned and implemented with new layout capabilities. This will greatly improve the efficiency of resource sharing request handling on both the borrower and the lender side for all types of requests.
