

## How to check if tablespaces are autoextend

### Question

How to check if Oracle tablespaces are in autoextend mode and what is the defined maximum size (in Oracle 11/11r2 the maximum is 32Gb)?

### Answer

The following SQL from the aleph user prompt will show whether each Oracle datafile is autoextendable. (Autoextendability is defined at the datafile level.):

```
> s+ aleph_admin
select TABLESPACE_NAME, FILE_NAME,AUTOEXTENSIBLE,MAXBYTES from dba_Data_files where
TABLESPACE_NAME like 'TS__';
```

Check the values in AUTOEXTENSIBLE column; if it's NO this feature is not enabled on the file in column FILE\_NAME.
