Where is a log of completed IE delete processes?

---

### Answer

1. Connect to the application server via ssh
2. Enter "dps\_log" (without quotes) which goes to /exlibris/dps/d4\_1/profile/operational\_shared/logs/
3. more server.log
4. Search the log for "successfully deleted"
