## translate BASKET in myself-delete-doc (delete from My e-Shelf)

### Problem Symptoms:

When selecting a record in My e-Shelf and clicking "Delete", the following message is displayed: "Are you sure you want to delete the document from BASKET?".

The word "BASKET" is apparently hardcoded and cannot be translated to another language.

### Cause:

The word "BASKET" is hardcoded until version 20. In the file myself-delete-doc there is no option to translate it.

### Resolution:

The problem is solved with rep\_change 2192 (Aleph 21):

Fix Number: 002192

Description: Web OPAC > My e-Shelf > Folder Management > Right pane (Basket management) - When selecting a "BASKET" record and clicking "Delete", the following message is displayed: "Are you sure you want to delete the document from BASKET ?". However, the word "BASKET" is hard-coded - it is always in English and there is no way to translate it.

Solution: This has been corrected. Instead of "BASKET", the system now uses the text from message 9522 in \$alephe\_root/error\_lng/www\_f\_heading:

9522 L BASKET
