## Electronic resources with no items have 'Check holdings' in Primo

- **Article Type:** General

### Problem Symptoms:

\* When no items are attached to a bib record, Primo -- and the AVA field being sent to Primo -- have "Check holdings" for Availability.

\* Items for electronic resources (with an 856 field), an HOL record \*is\* created. These appear in the AVA field as "Unavailable".

### Cause:

Primo configuration options.

### Resolution:

There are 2 options:

1. Configure PRIMO to see another text instead of "Check Holdings" in Primo BO: code table-> subsystem "delivery" -> code table "Calculated availability Text".
2. Configure Primo normalization rules and tables to enable publishing of the records when there's an 856 field.
