

Recalled overdue items not always using recall fine rate

- **Article Type:** General

Problem Symptoms:

The regular overdue fine rate is being charged in the case where the item is recalled on or after its (regular) due date. (It's OK if the recall occurs *before* the item's due date.) The recall-overdue fine rate should be used.

Cause:

Working as designed.

Resolution:

Aleph calculates and creates separate z31 (Cash Transaction) records for the **recall** overdue fine and the **regular** overdue fine.

The calculation of the recall overdue fine is described in Article "[How are recall overdue fines calculated?](#)"

If the z36_recall_overdue_date has not yet been reached, there will be no recall overdue fine. There is no provision in Aleph for making the recall-overdue-date be earlier because the item was overdue at the time it was recalled.
