## Replication enhancements redirection

- **Article Type:** General
  - **Product:** Aleph

### Problem Symptoms:

With the special routine UE11-G in xxx01/tab/tab\_merge

UE11-G merge\_doc\_overlay 98

it should be possible to add fields from redirected local record to the new record which also have EXP field.

But the local field EXP from the old record is not added to the new record.

### Cause:

There is a wrong definition in xxx01/tab/tab\_merge\_overlay for routine 98

### Resolution:

Change the entries for field EXP in xxx01/tab/tab\_merge\_overlay from

98 2 C EXP##

to

98 2 Y EXP##

The EXP field from the old record will be transferred to the new record.

The column 3 must be set to Y, because in the new record there is also a field EXP.

If you want to add also all EXP fields regardless if there is already one in the new record you have to add "Y" instead of "C".
