
No a-tree alephe directory after running Upgrade Express

Question

After running the 20-21 Upgrade Express, there's an `./a21_1/aleph` and an `./alephe.orig` directory, but no `./a21_1/alephe` directory. Is this a problem?

Answer

Upgrade Express moves the `./a2_n/alephe` directory to `./a2n_n/alephe.orig`. After Upgrade Express runs there is no `./a2n_n/alephe` directory. It is *not* needed by the system; it's just for reference. The subsequent Service Pack's create the `./a2n_n/alephe`, with whatever subdirectories they require, containing the files generated by the Service Pack's fixes.

Thus, after Upgrade Express runs and before the first Service Pack, it is correct and proper for there to be no `./a2n_n/alephe` directory.
