## How to configure Hold requests period ("To-date")

Desired Outcome Goal:

Understand how to configure the default "from date" and "to date" ("last interest date") parameters, for the GUI and the Web.

Procedure:

1. To set the default "End Date" ...

For GUI: set parameter in `$alephe_root/pc_server_defaults`: `setenv pc_z37_date_to`

For Web: set parameter in `$alephe_root/www_server.conf`: `setenv www_z37_date_to`

2. Restart pc server and/or www server.

### Additional Information

The default "From Date" which appears in the GUI Create Hold Request screen and the Web screen is hardcoded as today's date + 1.

Examples:

The following in `pc_server_defaults` entry yields a 6 month interest date in the GUI:

```
setenv pc_z37_date_to M006
```

and the following in `./www_server.conf` yields a 2 month date in the Web:

```
setenv www_z37_date_to M002
```

The following will be a 7 day interest date in GUI:

```
setenv pc_z37_date_to D007
```

and the following, 7 days in the Web:

```
setenv www_z37_date_to D007
```
