Question

How to enable command searching in WebVoyage?

Answer

1. On the Voyager server, open webvoyage.properties located at: /m1/voyager/XXXdb/tomcat/vwebv/context/vwebv/ui/[SKIN NAME]/
2. Within webvoyage.properties locate the heading "Basic Search Codes".
3. To enable Command Search with relevance, locate and uncomment the following lines:

```
# page.search.basic.search.code.commSearchWithRel=  
# page.search.basic.search.code.commSearchWithRel.code=CMD*  
# page.search.basic.search.code.commSearchWithRel.order=11  
# page.search.basic.search.code.commSearchWithRel.display=Command Search with Relevance
```

4. To enable Command Search locate and uncomment the following lines:

```
# page.search.basic.search.code.commandSearch=  
# page.search.basic.search.code.commandSearch.code=CMD  
# page.search.basic.search.code.commandSearch.order=14  
# page.search.basic.search.code.commandSearch.display=Command Search
```

5. Save webvoyage.properties
 6. To use command search, you must select a command search type from the drop down in WebVoyage Basic Search.
