### Description:

1) What do you recommend for the SSLSessionCache setting in the ssl.conf?

SSLSessionCache none

is currently there and that gives us the [warn] Init: Session Cache is not configured message

2) What should the init.dat be running to start ssl? for version 16 we had this:

Y:apache:root:httpsd:/exlibris/aleph/u17\_7:../a17\_7:apachectls\_auto:httpsdctl

Does this apply any longer? If not what should be included in the init.dat to start ssl? Is this adequate and sufficient?

Y:apache:root:httpd:/exlibris/aleph/u17\_7:../a17\_7:apachectl\_auto:apachectl

### Resolution:

1) Do not use dbm, it may crash under solaris.

You can set the SSLSessionCache to use this line:

SSLSessionCache [shmcb://exlibris/aleph/u17\\_7/alephe/...scache\(512000\)](#)

2) The line in init.dat should be: Y:apache:root:httpd:/exlibris/aleph/u17\_7:../a17\_7:apachectl\_auto:apachectl
