## Indexing the ISBN

- **Article Type:** General
  - **Product:** Aleph
  - **Product Version:** 20

### Desired Outcome Goal:

How to index the ISBN so that it's not necessary to add a truncation sign at the end of the number when there is additional text in the ISBN like

0-02-865604-0 (vol. 1)

### Procedure:

In xxx01/tab/tab\_filing use the dedicated ISBN filing routine ISBN, e.g. change filing routine

21 del\_subfield

21 compress !@#\$\$%^&\*()\_+ -={}[]\|: ";<>? ,./~`

21 compress\_blank

to

21 F isbn

In that case the additional text is automatically suppressed from being indexed.

Restart or ue\_01 is required and a complete re-indexing if you want to add this rule also to all already indexed records.
