## adm\_libs.dat, hol\_libs.dat, util m/7, and library relation

### Description:

You find that the values in `./xxxnn/pc_tab/catalog adm_libs.dat` or `hol_libs.dat` change when you run UTIL M/7.

### Resolution:

The `adm_libs.dat` and `hol_libs.dat` entries are rebuilt by the `util m/7` utility using information in the `$alephe_tab/library_relation` file. For instance, if you have: `ADM xxx01 xxx50` in `library relation`, when `util m/7` is run for `xxx01`, it will rebuild the `./xxx01/pc_tab/catalog/adm_libs.dat` with a value of "xxx50". If these tables have incorrect values, you need to change the relevant line in `library_relation`. Note that multiple library relations for the same library must be placed on the same line. Like this: `ADM xxx01 xxx50 xxx51 *Not*` like this: `ADM xxx01 xxx50 ADM xxx01 xxx51` (Since there is room for only 10 libraries on a line, it can be a problem if you need more).
