## Is Server is Scheduled to Restart Automatically at Night?

### Question

Is a server is scheduled to restart automatically at night?

### Answer

Servers can be restarted either through (1) the Unix crontab or (2) the \$alephe\_tab/job\_list.

1. crontabs can be viewed with the "crontab -l" command. (To see the root crontab one needs to be user "root ".)
2. "cd \$alephe\_tab" to view the job\_list. As described in KCS Article # 1845, Restart Servers from job\_list ([https://exlibrisgroup.my.salesforce.com/articles/How\\_To/Restart-Servers-from-joblist](https://exlibrisgroup.my.salesforce.com/articles/How_To/Restart-Servers-from-joblist)), "server\_monitor -tks" and p\_sys\_01 are the relevant lines.
