Description:

A question from one of our DBAs - Does the Aleph database have to be named aleph0? If not, what files have changes that need to be made in order to maintain functionality?

Resolution:

Yes, you may change the database name from aleph0. ALEPH addresses the database only by the \$ORACLE_SID. So from an ALEPH perspective, you only have to change the \$ORACLE_SID environment variable in \$alephe_root/aleph_start to accommodate a change in database name:

```
setenv ORACLE_SID aleph0
```
