## ib\_logfile - InnoDB Configuration

### Description:

I was taking a look at the recovery options for the MySQL database, and I was confused about the 'ib\_logfile' files in /exlibris/sfx\_ver/sfx\_version\_3/data

I am not familiar with these. Is it possible to disable the InnoDB storage engine or is that being used by the system?

### Resolution:

SFX does not use InnoDB processes— so any of the innodb logs in /app/mysql/data are not related to SFX.

If you would like to stop using them, you can add:

```
skip-innodb
```

to the [mysqld] section of:

```
/app/mysql/data/my.cnf
```

and then restart mysql using option 1 of our server\_admin\_util tool.
