### Description:

In the Navigation tree listing of records, we would like to display title instead of system number. Help says this depends on your system setup, but couldn't find how to do this in documentation.

### Resolution:

Please see System Librarian's Guide - Cataloging, p.107:

#### ShowDetailedInfo=N

ShowDetailedInfo determines whether or not (NEWnnn.MRC) will be presented for every opened record in the record tree or detailed information that includes title, author, system number, format and/or year.

When ShowDetailedInfo=N, the default (NEWnnn.MRC) will appear.

When ShowDetailedInfo=Y, a detailed information will be presented in the record tree.

To enable this, set message number 2004 in ./aleph/error\_eng/pc\_cat\_c0203.

Here is an example:
