## ARC ETL Log: "Minimum date invalid in configuration file"

### Description:

We have been noticing that some ETL logs on our ALEPH server are reporting the following error during the ETL process:

```
Load: /exlibris/aleph/u16_3/duk50/tab/arc_conf_table.conf
```

```
Minimum date invalid in configuration file
```

```
Start time is 23:15:59
```

```
End time is 23:15:59
```

We have never adjusted the minimum date setting in our arc\_conf\_table.conf file and it is set to the same value that is provided in the "ARC 1.1 - ALEPH Configuration for ARC.pdf" guide:

```
[ARC-HISTORY]
```

```
from year = 2004
```

We do not know why this setting sometimes throws an error in our ETL log, and why sometimes it does not, nor do we know how to fix this (or if it's a problem to be concerned with).

Do you have any information about this error and any suggestions on how to fix it?

### Resolution:

The message refers to a bad date in arc\_conf\_table.conf file , if the the events/opace events date given is later than the last date in the DB this message is generated.

The message no longer appears in your latest ETL log in \$alephe\_scratch.
