## Loans not changing state to LOST

### Description:

Patron 988402234 has 5 overdue books which should have changed to Lost and the \$45 lost charge applied.

Why didn't this happen?

### Resolution:

Looking at your tab32, I see that loans *should* be set to Lost after the second notice.

p\_cir\_51 has a "Type of Letter" parameter with possible values of "Overdue notice", "Bill for lost item", or "All of the above". (See KB 6588 in regard to a potential problem with "All of the above".)

Most sites do one run for Overdue notices and a second for Bills.

Looking in \$alephe\_scratch, I see that all the p\_cir\_51 "p\_letter\_type"s are "O":

```

You need to add a second job\_list entry for p\_cir\_51 (or p\_cir\_50) with p\_letter type "L".
