## How to determine default first web OPAC page when using PDS

### Description:

How to automatically define that the default first web OPAC page when using PDS will be the login page?

When PDS is not used the default first page is \$alephe\_root/www\_f\_eng/login

When PDS is used the default first page is \$alephe\_root/www\_f\_eng/find-b

How can this be changed to the PDS login page?

### Resolution:

This can be done by the following:

1) Copy the file pds-login to pds-login-first.

2) In pds-login-first change the following line:

```
var url = '&server_pds?func=load-login&calling_system=aleph&institute=$0200&url=&pds_backlink?$0100';
```

to:

```
var url = '&server_pds?func=load-
```

```
login&calling_system=aleph&institute=$0200&url=&pds_backlink?func=file&file_name=find-b';
```

3) In \$alephe\_root/www\_server.conf , define:

```
setenv www_login "PDS-LOGIN-FIRST"
```

4) Restart the server.

Note: You can also define a different file name that you want to display after login. In any case, do not use variables as it will not work.
