

## p\_manage\_02: drop z01\_id1 ... index does not exist

### Description:

I ran p\_manage\_02 on xxx10. The log file "xxx10\_p\_manage\_02.log" has an error:.

```
SQL-ALEPH_ADMIN> drop index xxx10.z02_id1.
```

```
ERROR at line 1:.
```

```
ORA-01418: specified index does not exist..
```

But now that the job is done, UTIL-A-17-14 shows that the z01\_id1 exists and is valid. What should be done to fix this?

### Resolution:

There are different scenarios where a job could be trying to drop an index which (correctly) does not exist. (For instance, if a preceding run failed or was canceled.).

As long as it ends up OK, you don't need to worry about it..

If the message occurs in trying to \*create\* an index, that usually indicates a problem.
