### Description:

When oracle is restarted it appears to work (e.g. can connect to Meditor, etc.). However I found this in the `/exlibris/app/oracle/admin/dtl3/bdump/alert_dtl3.log`

Cannot determine all dependent dynamic libraries for `/proc/self/exe`

The `open()` system call failed for the file `/proc/self/exe`

Should I be concerned?

### Resolution:

Our DBAs have checked this error message with Oracle support, and this is their response:

This is a known but harmless bug in the Oracle software.

Oracle recommends that you ignore this error message.
