### Description:

#### Problem Description:

- (1)\$aleph\_root/pc\_b\_eng/p-ill-74.xml – text label is incorrect
- (2)\$aleph\_dev/xxx40/ill-request-report.xml – text label is incorrect
- (3)Help for p-ill-74 doesn't distinguish as to which date it is comparing to

#### Actual Results:

- (1)\$aleph\_root/pc\_b\_eng/p-ill-74.xml line 15 reads:  
<label>Requests Created After</label>
- (2)\$aleph\_dev/xxx40/ill-request-report.xml line 42 reads:  
<xsl:with-param name="label" select="Requested Created After:"/>
- (3)Help for p-ill-74 doesn't have any information on the dates

#### Expected Results:

- (1)\$aleph\_root/pc\_b\_eng/p-ill-74.xml line 15 should read:  
<label>Requests Created On or After</label>
- (2)\$aleph\_dev/xxx40/ill-request-report.xml line 42 reads:  
<xsl:with-param name="label" select="Requests Created On or After:"/>
- (3)Help for p-ill-74 could have the following:

- <form-date> is the date the form (p-ill-74.xml) was submitted
- <date> is the date entered on the form for "Requests Created On or After"
- <z13-open-date> is the date the short bibliographic record was created
- <z13-update-date> is the date the short bibliographic record was last updated.
- <z410-open-date> is the date the interlibrary loan (ILL) borrowing request record was opened
- <z410-update-date> is the date the interlibrary loan (ILL) borrowing request record was modified
- <z410-last-interest-date> is the last date of interest for the interlibrary loan (ILL) borrowing request

For this report the <date> field, as entered in the p-ill-74.xml form, is compared to the <z410-open-date> to determine what records to pull
