### Description:

The server jobs in our job\_list are creating a lot of server\_monitor -tks files in \$alephe\_scratch.

How do you clean them up? util x doesn't do it.

### Resolution:

I don't know of a way to prevent these files from being created.

The following commands can be used to delete the logs:

```
> cd $alephe_scratch
> rm server_monitor*
```

Or, you can add the following lines to your \$alephe\_root/aleph\_startup file to delete them each time aleph is restarted:

```
#####
# Delete server_monitor logs from $alephe_scratch
#####

echo "Deleting server_monitor logs from $alephe_scratch"
cd $alephe_scratch
rm server_monitor*
```
