### Resolution:

Looking at Article 000013400, I did:

```
abc50@ALEPH0> select count(*) from z34;
```

```
**** Hit return to continue ****
```

```
COUNT(*)
```

```

```

```
9999994
```

Per Articles 000013400 and 000004879 ("When are z34's written? z34 vs. z69"), you don't need the z34. We suggest that in \$alephe\_root/www\_server.conf you change

```
create_statistics Y
```

to

```
create_statistics N
```

(The same change can and should be made in the \$alephe\_root/pc\_server\_defaults.)
