## Stopping ue processes before running job; lock\_library proc

### Description:

Do I need to stop ue\_01 before running p\_file\_96 or p\_manage\_18?

And, in general, what jobs lock the library?

### Resolution:

The \$aleph\_proc/lock\_library procedure stops all the ue processes. (And the unlock\_library proc restarts them.)

If a job does not execute lock\_library, Development has been determined that the ue processes can be left running for this job.

You can look at the proc in \$aleph\_proc to see if it executes lock\_library (and unlock\_library).

p\_file\_96 does not execute lock\_library.

p\_manage\_18 executes lock\_library if the p\_update\_mode is "S" (single-user). If it is "M" (multi-user), it does not.
