

## User denied permission for function 'Staff privileges

### Description:

After upgrading, when I click on "Staff Privileges" (in the "Key pop-up" on the right-hand side of the bottom toolbar), I get the error message: "User denied permission for function 'Staff privileges (Passwords)(PASSWORD))/User list - Display (USER-LIST)" -- even though my login had PASSWORD permission in the old version and SQL SELECT in the Z67 shows that my login \*does\* have PASSWORD permission in the new version.

### Resolution:

The pw\_library entry in aleph\_start (or aleph\_start.private) needs to be UPPER case:.

setenv pw\_library ABC50.

not:.

setenv pw\_library abc50.

Note: the pw\_library, usr\_library, and z105\_library setenv's need to be uppercase:.

setenv pw\_library ABC50.

setenv usr\_library ABC50.

setenv z105\_library ABC50.

In all other setenv's in aleph\_start, the library must be lowercase:.

Such as:.

setenv abc50\_dev \${USER\_MOUNT}/u\${ALEPH\_VERSION}\_\$ALEPH\_COPY.

setenv ALEPH\_LIBS "\$ALEPH\_LIBS abc01 abc30 abc50 abc60".

setenv REQUEST\_STARTUP\_LIBS "abc50"
