Is there a command which will show me what Oracle Critical Patch Updates are present on a server?

### Resolution:

login as the oracle unix user, then:

```
> sqlplus / as sysdba
```

run the following in a sqlplus session:

```
set line 200 pause off
col action_time for a28
col action for a10
col namespace for a9
col version for a10
col id for 99999999
col comments for a20
select * from registry$history order by 1;
```
