How is EOD different from EDI?

Answer

Embedded Order Data (EOD) imports records and creates POs in a single, automated step. The "Order" information in *SysAdmin > Cataloging > Bulk Import Rules* is where you set this workflow up.

Unlike **Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)**, you don't need to wait for Ex Libris *to approve a vendor* before you can use EOD.

EDI is used from the Acquisitions client.
