

## Speeding up ADM indexing jobs

### Description:

Can p\_manage\_111 run multi-process? Can the p\_acq\_04, p\_cir\_25, and p\_manage\_111 jobs be run at the same time?

### Resolution:

As can be seen by looking at the \$aleph\_proc/p\_manage\_111, manage\_111 is single-process; it can't run multi-process.. What we usually do with these jobs is to run them while the indexing jobs are running in the BIB library. The libraries are each independent. You can have jobs running in the BIB, Authority, and ADM libraries simultaneously without any problem.. I would say that you could definitely run p\_acq\_04 (since it is reading ACQtables) at the same time as one of the others.. p\_manage\_111 and p\_cir\_25 read some of the same (circ) tables but since they are not \*writing\* to the same tables, it would also be OK to run those at the same time.
