Question

Why is the number of z07 records increasing enormously when doing a global edit on the LKR field using “Global Changes (manage-21)”?

Answer

The sample records have lots of UP/DN links (and maybe the linked records itself have also linked records). In xxx01/tab/tab100 parameter INDEX-DN-LINK is set to yes which means that a z07 record is written for any linked record. Therefore it's logical that the number of z07 records is increasing.
