## Bib load removes spaces from 010 field; fix\_doc\_marc21\_spaces

### Description:

The bib load (p\_manage\_18, etc.) removes spaces from the 010 field.

The input 010 looks like this:

```
010 L $$a 88118634
```

the output, like this:

```
010 L $$a88118634
```

Or, for a name authority record:

```
010 L $$an 88118634
```

and:

```
010 L $$an 88118634
```

### Resolution:

The routine which preserves multiple spaces in the variable fields (010, 260, 310, 321, 362, 515, 525, 533, 76\*, 77\*, and 78\*) by changing them to carets is fix\_doc\_marc21\_spaces.

You need to execute this fix as part of whatever is loading these records.
