## Location of shutdown/startup logs on Hosted servers

### Question

Where are the shutdown/startup logs on hosted servers? -- showing, for instance, the startup following the application of a Service Pack on the server.

---

### Answer

When the startup is run via the /exlibris/startup/start\_stop script, an aleph\_startup.log file is produced in \$alephe\_root:

```
case "$1" in
'start')
/bin/su $suff $EXLIBRIS_OWNER -c "nohup ${alephe_dev}/${alephe_root}/${start_ut} >&
${alephe_dev}/${alephe_root}/${start_ut}.log"
;;
```

Since there's no date as part of the filename the log is overwritten with each start\_stop startup.

### Additional Information

The value of start\_ut is set in this line in start\_stop:

```
start_ut=`echo $_LINE | awk -F: '{print $5}' -`
```
