What controls the format of the bib info displayed in the GUI Circulation title bar?

Resolution:

The information in blue at the top of the screen comes from these lines in the \$alephe_error_eng (or, in 17.01-up, the \$aleph_error_eng):

pc_cir_c0461: 2001 0000 L BIB=$3 ADM=$4 - $1 ($2) Year: $5.
