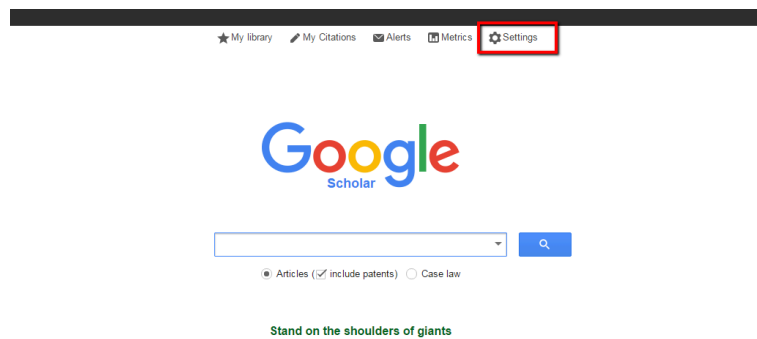

### Question

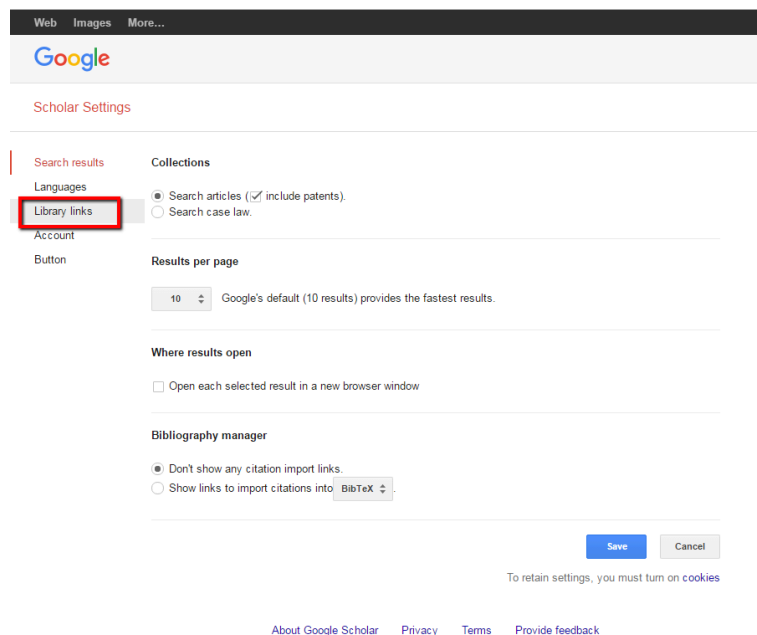
How do I check if Google Scholar has been updated with my institution's holdings?

### Answer

- Go to Google Scholar at: <http://scholar.google.com/>
- Select Settings (upper-right corner)



- Select "Library links" (left side of screen)



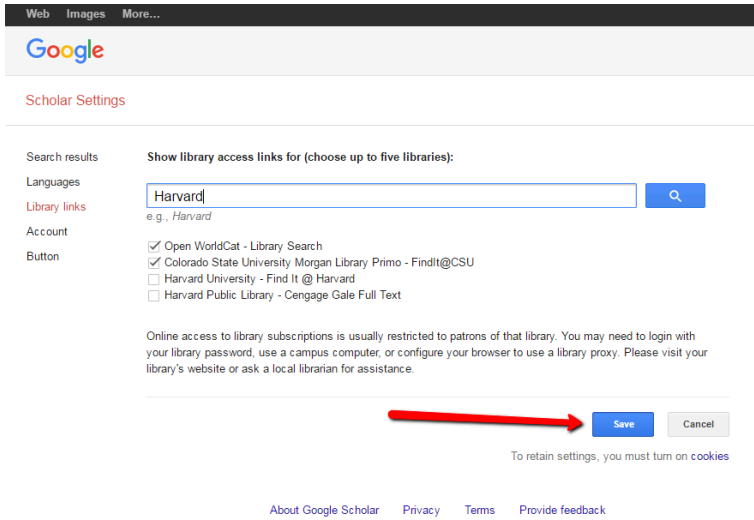
- Search for library keywords (defined in Resource Configuration Menu > Export Profiles > Publish Electronic Records to Google Scholar)

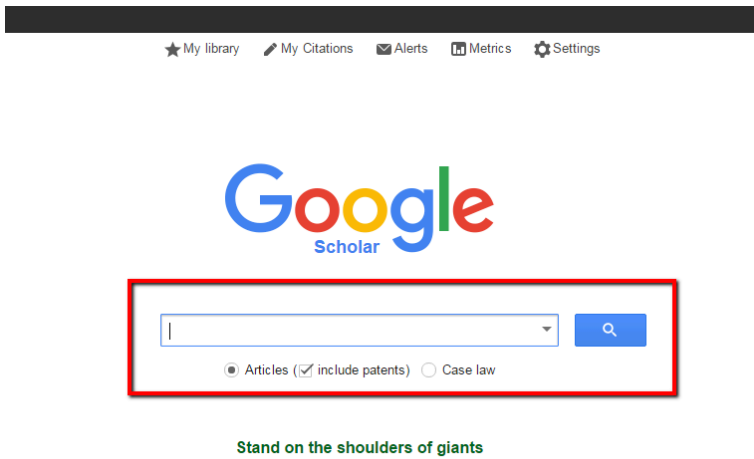
- Select the library
