Additional Information

For finding out all records which have a similar criterion do the following:

Add a line to ./xxx01/tab/tab_type_config.ing ?

```
TYP DEL LDR F05-01 EQUAL d
```

? and a line to ./xxx01/tab/tab_expand:

```
RET expand_doc_type tab_type_config
```

Then run Retrieve Catalog Records (ret-01) and search for all records that have in field TYP 'DEL' but not 'Y' in field 'DEL'.
