How to display top-level and sub-collections in Primo?

Answer

To add the Top-Level Collection to the "sub-records", please follow these steps:

1. Create a Set
2. Run it via a publish to Primo job

It should add a "COL" field to the XML sent to Primo.

Today, there are **out-of-the box normalization rules for this field (COL)**. They will need to be created in order to present or be able to search the information in Primo.
