

## OPAC DNS without "/F" directed to wrong server

- **Product:** Aleph
  - **Product Version:** 20, 21, 22, 23
  - **Relevant for Installation Type:** Dedicated-Direct, Direct, Local, Total Care

### Description

DNS <http://xxx.exlibrisgroup.com:8992> (without the "/F") is being directed to the wrong server (the Test server). DNS <http://xxx.exlibrisgroup.com:8992/F> (with the "/F") is redirected properly.

As described in Article "How to set the redirection when accessing `http://<WWW_HOST>:<HTTPD_PORT>` in Aleph", the relevant file is `$httpd_root/htdocs/.index.html`. The file's relevant line is:

```
var loc = "http://yyy.exlibrisgroup.com/F?RN=+session;
```

### Resolution:

This URL needs to point to the OPAC server (the server where the `www_server` is running for this particular Aleph instance) -- in this case, <http://xxx.exlibrisgroup.com/F> .
