
Obsolete smon_aleph20 oracle process running even after Oracle restart

Description:

After going from Aleph v20 to v22 (both on the same server) and eliminating the oracle `.../product/11 (v20)` line from `/exlibris/startup/init.dat` and restarting Oracle, `"ps -ef | grep smon_aleph20"` shows the `ora_smon_aleph20` process still running.

Resolution:

The `"ps -ef |grep"` shows that the `smon_aleph20` process was started on Aug12 (prior to the update of the `init.dat`):

```
oracle 26377 1 0 Aug12 ? 00:03:26 ora_smon_aleph20
```

A restart of this server did **not** occur after the move to version 22. Perhaps the 11r2 (v22) Oracle, but that would have had no effect on the already-running aleph20 Oracle process. Rebooting the server will stop this `ora_smon_aleph20`, and, assuming it's been omitted from `init.dat`, it will not be restarted.
