

## Configure Secure Cookies Creation in Apache

- **Product:** Aleph
  - **Product Version:** 20, 21, 22, 23
  - **Relevant for Installation Type:** Dedicated-Direct, Direct, Local, Total Care
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### Desired Outcome Goal:

Set Apache to add secure and httpOnly flags to cookies created by Apache

### Procedure:

1. Add this line to httpd.conf file:

Header always edit Set-Cookie ^(.\*)\$ \$1;HttpOnly;secure

2. In find-b, add the secure attribute to the JavaScript set cookie:

```
function setCookie() { document.cookie = "ALEPH_SESSION_ID = $SESS; path  
= /; secure"; }
```

HttpOnly can't be used since by definition this is a cookie set by JavaScript

3. Restart www\_server and Apache

### Additional Information

- \* Apache must be using SSL.
- \* The always condition is required when editing headers set by CGI scripts.

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
