## Create permanent link to search results in WEB OPAC

### Question

How to create a permanent link to Web OPAC search results set?

### Answer

1. Run the search in your Web OPAC.
2. At the search results set page, copy the URL.
3. From that URL, remove the **temporary session code** which is between the /F/ and the "?" sign

### Example

This is the URL created in the search session (in red, is the session code which should be remove):
