### Question

What is the SEARCHPARAM table in Voyager Prepackaged Access Reports?

### Answer

Data in the SEARCHPARAM table are defined in the SysAdmin client in:

SysAdmin > Search > Indexes - Composite Definitions

SysAdmin > Search > Indexes - Headings and Left-Anchored Definitions

SysAdmin > Search > Indexes - Keyword Definitions

SysAdmin > Search > Indexes - Holding Keyword Definitions.

- This table stores many of the indexing decisions that govern searching in Voyager.
- The searchcode field in SEARCHPARAM can be used to link to index\_code in the BIB\_INDEX and AUTH\_INDEX tables.
- The acqcount, catcount, circcount, and mediacount fields are incremented by Voyager during searches in the *staff clients*. They never display in the clients, but they make the most frequently used searches appear first in the search window.
- Similarly, the opaccount field makes the most frequently used keyword searches appear first on the *WebVoyage advanced search screen*.
- The [indexrules](#) field tells how each index is constructed.
