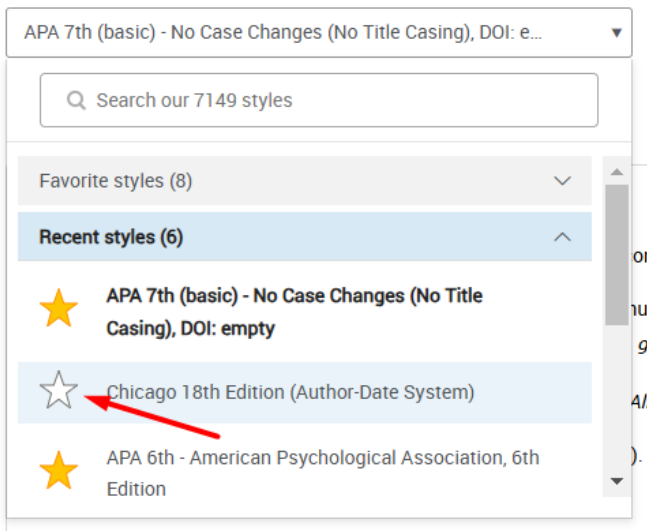


## How to build a list of favorite citation styles in RefWorks

Users may build a list of favorite citation styles in RefWorks, or in RefWorks Citation Manager (RCM) for Word and Google Docs, simply by selecting the star icon next to a style's name. These stars are found in front of the name of a citation style in all styles lists.

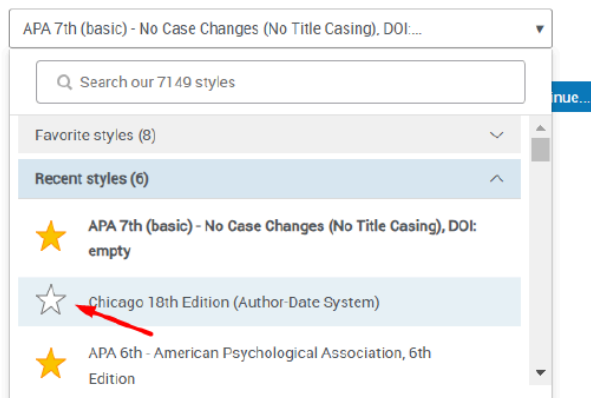
In RefWorks, in **Create Bibliography** or in **Quick cite**



### Choosing citation style in Create Bibliography

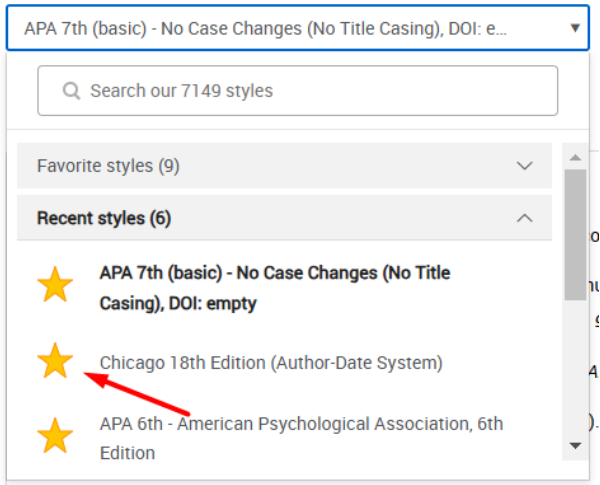
#### 1 | Choose your citation style

Choose the type of citation you'd like to add to your paper.

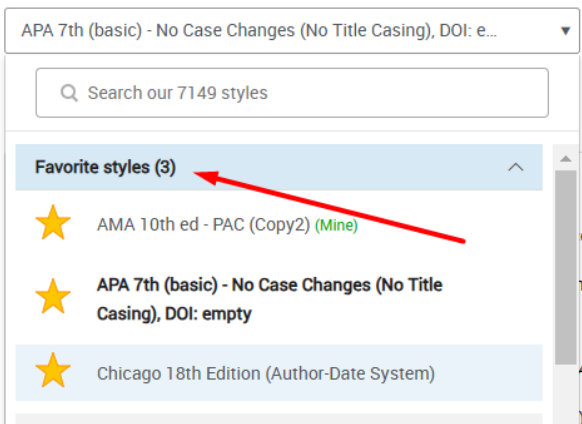


### Choosing citation style in Quick Cite

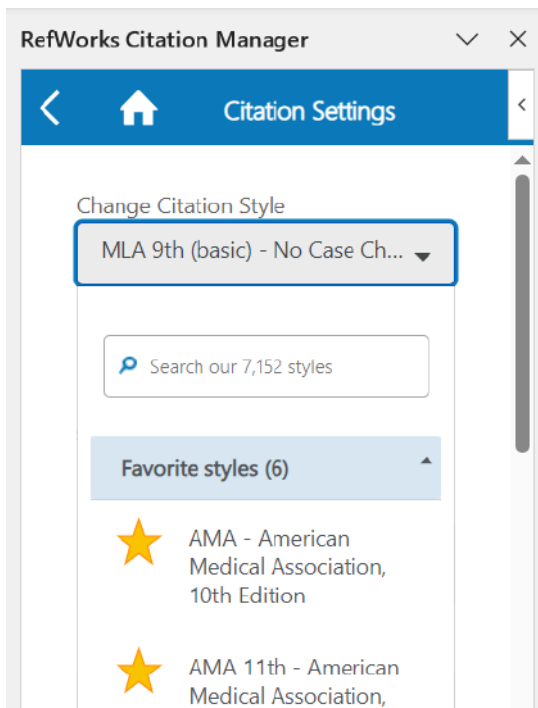
Once clicked, the the star turns yellow



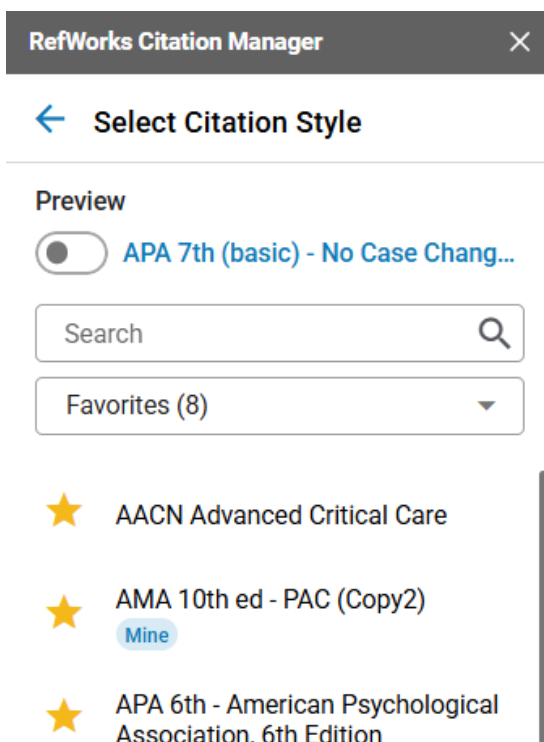
and adds the style to a list of favorites
