What is "Circulation Self Check"?

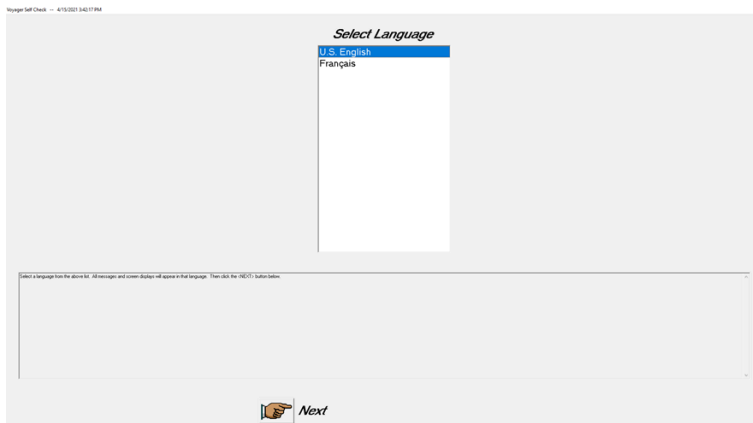
Answer

The Voyager "Circulation Self Check" allows your patrons to quickly charge items for themselves. The patron must enter their barcode and last name before being allowed to charge out items. The module can be configured for a variety of languages from which patrons can choose on the initial screen.

The Self-Check *Extension* module (sometimes referred to as "SIP2") is *not* required to run "Circulation Self Check." The latter is included with Voyager.

Set up, configuration and use of "Circulation Self Check" is documented in Appendix C of the [Circulation User's Guide](#).

Additional Information

As mentioned above, "Circulation Self Check" is included with Voyager, and should not be confused with the [Self Check Extension product](#) (sometimes referred to as "SIP2"), which must be licensed separately.
