

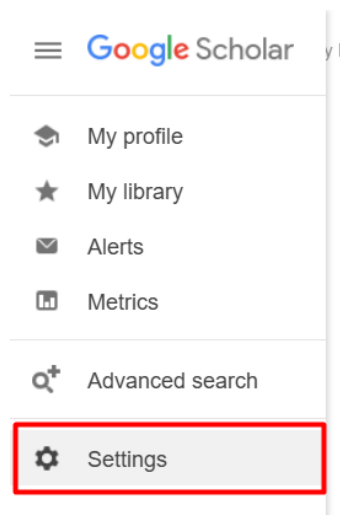
Adding "Import to RefWorks" to Google Scholar

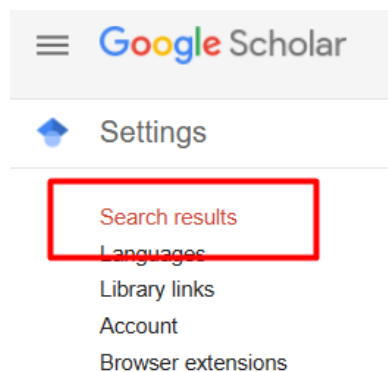
How do I add "Import to RefWorks" option to Google Scholar?

Answer

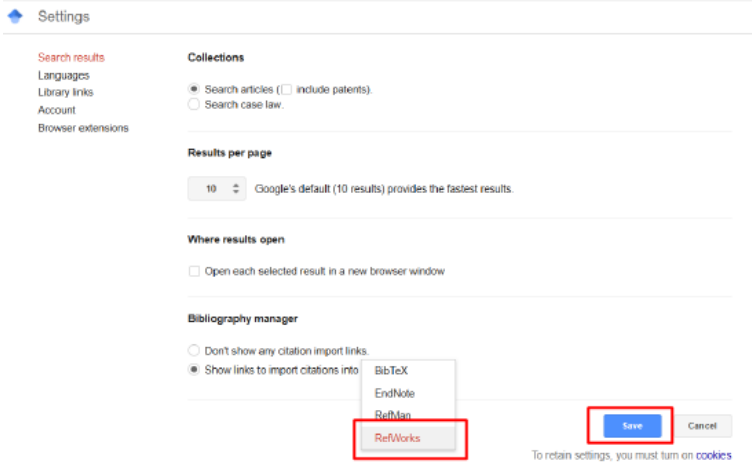
1. Launch **Google Scholar**
2. Click on the main **Google Scholar** menu (left-hand corner), select *Settings*



3. Go to **Search results**



4. Under **Bibliography manager** (bottom option), select *Show links to import citations into > RefWorks > Save*



Once saved, the option to *Import into RefWorks* will appear underneath each article.
